



Children and adults may bring their backpacks and briefcases for this event.


Hannah Olsen has designed the backpack tags for this year, so be sure to take one.



We are excited to start our 11th year and appreciate prayers for students and teachers.



InReach

InReach ministry serves YOU! This service falls under two headings Shepherding and Fellowship. If you want to know more about what we do, please come to a planning session and see if it might be a good fit. We meet in the library



Fellowship events are free (but donations are appreciated) unless otherwise announced. The only cover charge requested, not required, is a slip of paper with a bible verse accompanied with chapter and verse that is instructional, or rather, directs us toward righteous living. An example is James 3:8 "but no human being can tame the tongue. It is a restless evil, full of deadly poison". This verse reminds us to watch what we say and realize the harm we can cause; at the same time reminding us where to go for help in controlling our tongue. The hope is to compile all the verses into one booklet.

During July, we partnered with OutReach, and helped with the 4th of July celebration. InReach, provided individual bags of chips and cookies. Cookie bags had an invitation taped to each inviting those without a home church to join OSLC on Sundays at 10 am. We are also planning to host a light meal and bible based scavenger hunt on rally day with prizes. The hunt will be for adults and adult/youth teams. News From the Kitchen

With the 9:00 am social hour on Sundays, many more people are using the kitchen. So, it is time for some reminders.

Because we have the Melting Pot program, Health Department personnel come periodically to inspect our kitchen. They can shut down the program if we are found to be out of compliance. The rules for the kitchen are as follows:

- Large quantities of unlabeled food in the refrigerator or freezer are for the Melting Pot program. Foods put in the refrigerator or freezer by other groups or individuals <u>must be labeled</u> with names of responsible parties and the date. They will be disposed of at the 'use by' date.
- Unlabeled food <u>not</u> for Melting Pot <u>will</u> be thrown away.
- In the storage area behind the kitchen, three shelves are assigned to the Melting Pot program. Please <u>do not</u> take items from those shelves or store other items there.
- Try to put things where they belong on the labeled shelves so everyone can find what they are looking for.

Thank you from your kitchen volunteers for helping us to keep our kitchen clean, organized and in compliance.


